5.2.2.1.

The following document has been released to support the effort by DE&S to provide equipment and support to Ukraine following Russia's illegal invasion. The document sets out how taskings in support of Ukraine and Op SCORPIUS should be approached from a Safety & Environmental perspective.

The guidance within the document **only applies to taskings in support of Ukraine**, predominantly under Op SCORPIUS. Support to other Operations remains governed by ASEMS with appropriate approach for that Operation in consultation with Duty Holders, TLBs, Equipment Sponsors and guidance from QSEP.
