
The Safety Managers Toolkit

The Sustainable Procurement (SP) tool is live on the <u>ASEMS website</u> and provides a high-level screening tool for project teams to identify sustainability risks and opportunities.

The toolkit is easily accessible from POEMS and is aligned to established MOD environmental regulations and requirements which apply to equipment and support acquisition.

The introductory guide and SP toolkit (a 5-step method) are designed to be used together.






It will help you identify key SP issues that can be taken forward as part of the commercial process.

EFM The toolkit includes a separate section on Sustainable Procurement on the bottom of the EFM that allows you to consider not only risks but also the opportunities and costs.
