Description

1. The MOD Hazardous Materials Database (HazMat) is an RLI hosted application used to manage an inventory of platforms, equipment and components and to identify hazardous materials such as asbestos, halon and radioactive components that are present in these. This tool also facilitates the reporting of such substances and their elimination from the equipment programme.
2. Since its introduction, there has only been limited use of Hazmat by Operating Centres and Delivery/Project Teams and this low level use does not justify the continuing cost of licencing and hosting this product into the future.
3. As there has been no new requirement identified or significant support for the continuance of HazMat from the business, the tool will be withdrawn on 30 June 2016.
4. BMT will continue to provide low-level support in the absence of a support contract up until this date.
